Online Payment

Checks and cash are accepted by the school’s lunchroom cashier either as a pre-paid deposit to a student’s account or for purchasing individual meals, milk or a la carte items. Write your child’s first and last name in the memo line. Checks should be payable to: Tahoma Food Services.



Skyward

Every student has a school meal account. Parents/guardians may monitor their student’s account history and view purchases without a fee in [Skyward Family Access](#).

Parents may set a la Carte spending limits, and they may transfer funds between school meal accounts of siblings. The student’s account balance is carried forward to the next school year. Please contact Nutrition Services at foodservicehelp@tahomasd.us for more information.

The District sends emails and makes robo calls to notify parents/guardians when their student has a negative account balance. While Tahoma Nutrition Services will make every effort to notify the parent/guardian when a student has insufficient funds to purchase school meals, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to monitor the student’s account balance and ensure that funds are available by prepaying for school meals or sending a cash or check payment with their student. Families may also consider completing an **application for free and reduced priced meals** at any time during the school year.

Food Allergy Information

Tahoma School District has students with a wide variety of life-threatening allergies. We can create a plan to meet your student’s special needs with the help of school nurses and teachers. If your child is participating in our meal programs and you would like to request special dietary accommodation, please submit a **Special Dietary Accommodations form** to the school nurse or Nutrition Services. This form must be completed by your student’s physician or a licensed health care professional authorized to write medical prescriptions in Washington State.
